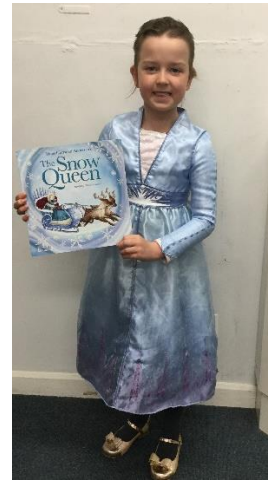

COVID update

As you are aware, the guidance on close contacts and isolation changed last week.

From the plan for living with Covid:

Until 1 April, we still advise people who test positive to stay at home. Adults and children who test positive are advised to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for at least five full days and then continue to follow the guidance until they have received two negative test results on consecutive days.

The UK Health Security Agency outlines that:

"Children and young people with COVID-19 should not attend their education setting while they are infectious."

Please continue to support us by ensuring the children are tested if they have symptoms and email us on longhorsleyadmin@fedlongwhaltschools.uk if your child tests positive and we will then expect them to self-isolate for 5 full days and until they have had 2 negative Covid tests.
