We will also be using the Read, Write, Inc program to ensure that the children are confident with all of their sounds and their reading skills, for those children who are secure in these we will focus on comprehension based skills.



In Mathematics, we will be following White Rose Maths guidance and developing the children's problem solving skills through practical tasks. This term we will be looking at number and place value, addition and

subtraction, shape, including both 2D and 3D shapes. The Year 2 children, will also be learning about money and multiplication and division too.
