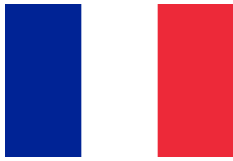




We will be exploring, investigating and challenging ourselves to learn lots of new things in our spring term curriculum journey.

French

We will revise our knowledge of colours and then move onto the names of shops and the produce that they sell. For example: boucherie, boulangerie ...



Computing

– we will continue to develop our skills using our school 360 platform. We need to learn to find the keys speedily on the keyboard too to maximise the time in our lessons. We will use programs to create music, to change the colour and size of our text, make a chart and a pictogram.

In English, we will explore fiction, non-fiction and poetry. We will investigate a variety of spoken language, composition, reading, comprehension and grammar, using a variety of texts to deepen our understanding.

Maths

In year 1, we will begin this term by exploring methods of adding and subtracting numbers up to 20, we will then move on to numbers up to 50 before using our amazing comparing skills as we look at length, weight and capacity measurement.



In year 2, we will be extending our knowledge of making equal groups by making these groups into multiplication and division calculations. We will explore different ways to record data, investigate the properties of shapes, and also dive into fractions.

Science

In our first half term we will be investigating the human body, our senses, and what we need to survive.

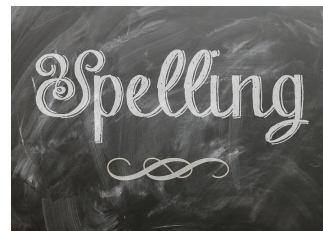


After half term it's time to get growing! We will design and plant our allotment space and closely observe how plants grow by planting our own 'bean in a bag!'
