Dear Children,

If you wish to, you may complete the following activities:

Spend half an hour **reading** one of the following:

- your school reading book
- a favourite book from home
- a newspaper/magazine
- an on-line news report about the weather conditions (Year 3 and 4)

Spend one hour **writing**. Choose **one** of the activities -

- Write a description of the view from your window. What can you see / hear / and how does it make you feel? If you have been out in the snow describe your experience. (Reception - draw a picture / Year 1 & 2 - write a short paragraph / Year 3 & 4 write a page)
- Write a letter to a friend /family member describing the weather and its effects e.g. school closed.
- Write a poem about the snow.

Maths - Spend 30 minutes to 45 minutes completing the following:

- Year 2- Learn your multiplication tables - 2x, 5x, 10x
- Year 3 - Learn your multiplication tables - 3x,4x,6x, 8x
- Year 4 - Learn your multiplication tables - 3x, 4x,6x,7x,8x, 9x, 11x, 12x
- Log on to BBC Bitesize maths
