Literacy

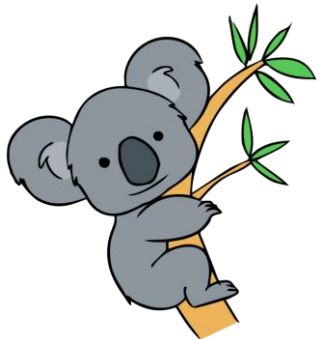
This term we will be exploring fiction stories from the recent past, attempting our own persuasive writing and looking at poems on the theme of monsters! As always, we will continue to focus on improving our reading, handwriting and spelling of Year 2 common exception words.

Numeracy

This term we will ensure that we continue to revisit the key skills that we need for all topics within the mathematics curriculum. We will spend lots of time on developing a secure understanding of fractions before moving on to the topics of measurement and time.

Science

In Science this Summer, we will find out about how different types of animals adapt to their habitats, as well as how they source food. We will also find out about some famous scientists and inventors later in the term.



Computing

This term, computing tasks will involve looking at creating computer coding and programs, so that we can bring sequences of commands to life! We will also ensure that we continue to be mindful about how to use computers and the internet safely.

Religious Education

We will look at the concept of the Kingdom of God this term, as well as what happened after the resurrection of Jesus. We will also look at the religion of Sikhism and investigate how Sikhs celebrate their religion.

Geography & History

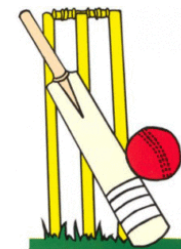


Art, Design & Technology
