## The Children's Art Show

- 1. Answers will vary.

- 3. The art show is open for two weeks.
- 4. Answers will vary. (the beach is fun; there are lots of things to see at the beach)
- 5. Children want to make their work look good because it is going in an art show.
- 6. The children glued things like sand, shells, seaweed and driftwood to their paintings.
- 7. The models were made from clay, paper or things found at the beach.
- 8. People love coming to the art show because the children's artwork makes them feel very happy.

### **From Sunset to Sunrise**

- 1. It took all night for the ferry to cross the sea.
- 2. The family went outside onto the top deck to get a good view of the sunset.
- 3. The setting sun looked like a big shiny ball on the water.

## **Bike Safety**

- 1. Children should wear helmets when they ride a bike to keep their head safe.
- 2. People can buy the right helmet at a bike shop.
- 3. The straps on a helmet have to be done up to keep the helmet on properly.
- 4. A child can check the bike is the right size by sitting on the bike seat and making sure their feet can be flat on the ground.
- 5. Tyres should feel hard if they are pushed.
- 6. Brakes need to work well in case the bike needs to stop quickly.

### **How to Make Bird Callers**

- 1. When you blow a duck caller, it makes a quack, quack sound.
- 2. You need to open the cut end of the straw when you blow it so that air can get through.
- 3. When you blow a coot caller, it makes a toot, toot sound.
- 4. A coot caller is shorter than a duck caller.
- 5. A bush-bird caller makes a squeaking sound.
- 6. A bush-bird sound is made by rubbing polystyrene against a glass.
- 7. You have to be careful not to drop the glass so that it doesn't break.
- 8. You have to wait quietly when calling birds, so that you don't scare them away.

## A Home Under the Ground

- 1. Some places are too hot to live above the ground, so people live in homes under the ground.
- 2. Tunnels from the mines make good homes because they are very big and cool.
