

<u>English</u>

The first text we will read in Year 3

<u>Maths</u>

We begin the year looking at Place Value. The children will be representing and partitioning numbers to 100 and 1,000. We will also explore flexible partitioning of numbers to 1,000, then finding 1, 10 and 100 more or less. This will facilitate children in estimating (on a number line), ordering and comparing numbers to 1,000, before learning to count in 50's.

<u>Science</u>

Our topic: Animals including Humans. We will be investigating nutrition and identifying that humans, and some other animals, have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement. Our Key Scientist focus will be Marie Curie.

<u>History</u> Our historical journey in Year 3 looks at the Vikings. This is a fantastic period of history to study with great significance for us in the North East of England!

PE

In addition to our swimming lessons, we will be exploring Rugby. Tag rugby is a noncontact version of rugby; it doesn't include tackling. Passing and keeping possession of the ball is one of the fundamental skills in any invasion game. The children will learn a number of skills to practise moving with the ball.

French

In French, we will be learning to discuss ourselves, parts of the body and what we wear.

<u>Art</u>

In Art this half term, we will be looking at Mythical Creatures: drawing, painting and collage. Artists like Ivan Belikov, Daniele Caruso, Victor Sukhochev will be explored, as we research and investigate art from across the world, before creating our own.

<u>Music</u>

We will be inventing a musical story in music this half term. We will consider how music can be used to tell a story and express our feelings.

<u>Computing</u> In Connecting Computers, we will explain how digital devices function, recognising the physical components of a network.

<u>PSHE</u>

We begin our PSHE work looking at our mental and physical health. In particular, we will consider our Zones of Regulation.

<u>RE</u>

We will begin the year looking at 'The Big Frieze' an overview of the core concepts seen in the Bible. We will then look closely at the story of Creation.
