
## School Photographs

## Robinwood Trip for Year 4 May 2025:

Next year, our annual Year 4 residential visit has been arranged again with Cambo, Whalton and Longhorsley children. It will take place from Monday 12th - Wednesday 14th May 2025 at Robinwood Activity Centre, Barhaugh Hall, Alston.

Robinwood holds 'Learning Outside the Classroom' accreditation and has "fantastic indoor provision for three challenging high activities; an impressive climbing wall, crate challenge with emphasis on teamwork and trapeze with platform options to leap from two different levels. Indoor provision means that these high activities can continue whatever the weather, but we will also be using the outdoor trapeze in the trees in the grounds at Barhaugh Hall as an option in good weather.



There are further indoor areas in the grounds for the Dungeon and Piranha Pool; wonderful themed problem solving areas developed by the Robinwood staff team. However, the best thing about it is the opportunity for the children to mix with and meet their Federation friends/neighbours and other children who will also be moving on to our local middle schools in Year 5, as well as challenging themselves physically and mentally -all mixed with a huge amount of fun!

School will be subsidising the costs of the residential by £50 per pupil from its sports premium funding so it remains at the same cost from previous years which is £200. There will be the opportunity to pay this in full or in instalments. All information needed will be shared nearer the time at the Parents' meeting.

As you know, we have recently joined with other local schools to become the Font Alliance and as a group of schools think it would be a great idea to have a logo to show our commitment to this partnership. # Teacher Training Day:

Just a reminder that school has a teacher training day on Friday 25th October, which is a great opportunity to get away for the half term break earlier and miss the rush, as well as saving some pennies!

#### School Dinners and Packed Lunches:

Longhorsley St Helen's First School has a Healthy School Policy for Packed Lunches using guidelines from School Food Trust and Department of Health. We ask that parents follow these guidelines when sending in packed lunches and ensure that snacks for break time are fruit only too (no crisps or chocolate biscuits please). Many thanks for your support with this.

Packed lunches should include:

- at least one portion of fruit and/or one portion of vegetables every day;
- lean meat, fish, eggs or other source of non-dairy protein (eg lentils, kidney beans chickpeas, hummus, falafel) every day;
- oily fish;
- a starchy food such as wholemeal bread, wrap, pitta pocket, plain bread sticks, plain crackers, plain unsalted rice cakes, pasta, rice, couscous, noodles, potatoes or other type of cereals every day;
- dairy food such as milk, cheese, yoghurt, fromage frais or custard;
- a drink only still water, unsweetened fruit juice, semi-skimmed or skimmed unflavoured milk, flavoured milk (occasionally as this has more added sugar than plain milk)

If you wish to move your child to packed lunches at any time, please let us know a term in advance, as produce is ordered in advance. Packed lunch children can also choose to have a school dinner on Fridays and for special occasions - please just email school.
