School Improvements

Start and Finishing times of the School Day

School gates open at 8.45am for 8.50am start in all year groups. Children come straight into school whilst we ask that Reception and Nursery children are dropped off in their cloakroom please. Morning Nursery finishes at 11.50am and children are picked up from the main school gate. Afternoon nursery starts at 12.30, please bring children to the main office and then pick them up from the main playground at 3.30pm.

At home time, 3.20pm, all children are led out in their classes and dismissed by their teachers in allocated areas of the playground. Please note that you are allowed to come into the playground for pick up. We will be operating an 'in and out' system to help - in through the single school gate, then out through the double gate to help with congestion please - many thanks for your support in this!

Please remember to let the office know if someone other than parents are picking up your child for safeguarding reasons and to share this information with them please, on the who can my child go home with list, thank you. We will check if they aren't, so please do not be offended if we then ring parents to check. Safety of all children is paramount at our school.
